

A year of immeasurable loss, in 2018 we witnessed some of the worst flooding in Trinidad spanning areas across East, Central and South requiring that we immediately lend assistance to those affected householders.

While the country as a whole got together to assist, the PMCGC galvanized to action by distributing much needed Cleaning Supplies and Sanitation Products. Food Hampers of mainly canned foods and Water followed immediately together with



Assistance to several kitchens, and regional corporations that were delivering aid and Hot Meals to the affected. After the clean up exercise disbursement were made to several families that lost most of their household items to the flood waters with replacement of basic household items like Refrigerators, Stoves and Mattresses and some much needed Home Repairs. Over 120 food hampers were delivered to the southern area as far as Mayaro/Rio Claro areas. The Total Disbursed for this relief effort was: approx. \$50,000.00



Recognizing that we need to stem the cycle of poverty through education, we expanded our Secondary School Bursary program to Five Schools throughout Trinidad and Tobago to afford the less fortunate children in those schools to avail themselves of School Books, Uniforms and defray Travelling Expenses to and from school This amounts to \$50,000.00 annually.

Our Back to School Initiative took as to the children of Dow Village Government Primary School in Couva for the supply of schoolbooks together with a grocery hamper. The children of Cedros/Pt. Fortin, and the Debe/Penal environs also received school books and uniform.

Total disbursed \$50,000.00





This is in addition to our monthly assistance of Rent and Travelling expenses to Students pursuing Tertiary Education at UWI, COSTATT- and UTT . - \$35,000.00

The CP Society has again asked for us to defray the cost of a visit by Dr. Carillo, a therapist who trains parents and caregivers in the proper care of those suffering with CP, in addition to the materials and equipment to be purchased for use in their Centre just opened by the GOTT. This is estimated to cost approx.. \$60,000.00

The Charity, in addition to these, have continued with the daily assistance of numerous persons requiring assistance for medical to the tune of \$75k; this year we assisted persons travelling abroad ,eg for Liver Transplant in India; the Airfare alone was in excess of \$17,000.00

We recently purchased Airline Tickets for a child and parent to travel to Italy for specialized treatment to the cost of \$15,000.00.specialized cancer treatments. Other Medical Assistance for the most basic needs of eye glasses, crutches, wheelchairs and the likes. This is on a case by case basis and is investigated by the charity committee; but that is what we are here for: To Help Those Who Need it Most , WITH the continued support of our gracious Sponsors.

Throughout the length and breadth of Trinidad and Tobago over 325 Christmas Hampers were distributed and students of several schools enjoyed Christmas treat in 2018 totaling \$150,000.00.
